The Faculty of Health Sciences and Medicine and the Royal Flying Doctor Service (Queensland Section) are pleased to announce a new Postgraduate course dedicated to the unique specialty of Retrieval Medicine. The course will have multiple exit points as follows:

- > Graduate Certificate in Retrieval Medicine (4 subjects)
- > Postgraduate Diploma in Retrieval Medicine (8 subjects)
- > Master of Retrieval Medicine (10 subjects)

Delivered as a partnership between Bond University's Faculty of Health Sciences and Medicine and the Royal Flying Doctor Service (Queensland Section), the program will be conducted in part-time mode using a flexible and interactive online delivery method as well as an intensive 3-4 day residential component each semester. The residencies will be conducted in a range of venues including off-site Royal Flying Doctor Service bases and the Faculty's teaching facilities.

Designed for health professionals working or planning to work in this area, the program aims to equip students with advanced skills in, and an excellent understanding of, all aspects of the challenging field of retrieval medicine.

One residential per semester is planned to accommodate the two subjects offered in that semester. The first residential component* of the program will be based at Bond University on the Gold Coast from 3-6 November 2012.

- > Undergraduate degree or equivalent in medicine, nursing or paramedic science
- > Current Australian or New Zealand relevant health professional registration or equivalent
